LAURENTIEN TREE WORK 2.0

Dear Members,

As you may recall, we removed a few trees last fall. We say a few because it is only a fraction of what we had accomplished in 2014 as part of the Laurentien Tree Work Program. Our architect visited in September of 2015 to review the work accomplished. Ian Andrew was exceptionally pleased with the work and recommended some additional removal. We have dubbed this "Laurentien Tree Work 2.0".

This season we have added additional staff to increase the quality of our golfing product. Upon completion of spring time cultural practices, our focus will be on the cleanup and beautification of these affected areas including #2, #5, #7, #9, #13 and #15. We have completed the cutting portion and some areas are already prepared for sod.

Whereas most areas saw large clusters cleared, #7 and #13 had trees slated for removal at a later date but required expediting as their rooting caused major damage on their respective fairways.

At the request of the Match and Handicap Committee, all the affected areas are deemed GROUND UNDER REPAIR until further notice. This will include areas where tree stumps still exist. For further information we refer you to the Club Captain or Professional Staff.
